What Is West Nile Virus (WNV)?

West Nile Virus is an established seasonal epidemic in our region that is most common during the summer and fall. WNV is the leading cause of mosquito-borne illness in the United States, and there are currently no vaccines or medications to prevent the disease.

Fortunately, most people infected with WNV will experience no symptoms. Approximately 1 in 5 people will develop fever or flu-like symptoms, and 1 in 150 may develop serious, or sometimes fatal, complications.

What Can I Do to Prevent WNV?

The first step toward protecting you, your family, and your community from WNV is to reduce the number of mosquitoes that can spread the disease. You can help by removing all standing water around your home or business. See other helpful tips on the other side of this card.
